Case Studies

A student who was excellent at art

When she discovered how important the need to have security was for her she realised why she was struggling. The traditional artist's existence of self - employment, critiques and having to sell her image to the public was anything but safe and secure. This knowledge enabled her to take a different course and become an art teacher in a secure environment. Once she was secure in her career her whole life flourished.

A brilliant scientist at school

Will was top of his class in science and thought about pursuing a medical career. He was going to follow in his grandfather's footsteps and become a surgeon. However, when he did his profile in this program, he discovered that he would not work well under high stress and that he needed deep meaning in his work over precision and excellence. In other words, the life of a surgeon was not for him! Instead he chose to pursue Psychiatry which would help him and others to find meaning in their lives.
